ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE AND TAX LEVY FOR DEBT SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION FOR THE HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 FOR THE TAX YEAR ENDING THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER 2017, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS PROVIDING FOR A HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

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HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, the voters of Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 (the "District") have authorized the levy and collection of a tax for repayment of the District's bonds and maintenance and operation purposes, to be assessed on the ad valorem basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") has previously fixed a rate of tax in the amount of \$0.22 per \$100.00, of which \$0.12 of the ad valorem tax was distributed to the Debt Service Fund and \$0.10 of the ad valorem tax was distributed to the Maintenance and Operation Tax Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the rate of tax to \$0.41 per \$100.00 will provide adequate revenue for the repayment of the District's bonds and to maintain and operate the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the continuation of its ad valorem tax exemptions will not impair the repayment of the District's bonds; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1:

Section 1: There shall be and is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected for the tax year ending December 31, 2017, an ad valorem tax of \$0.41 for each One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars of assessed value of property located within the boundaries of the District on January 1, 2017, as valued by the Harris County Central Appraisal District and made taxable by law.

Section 2: The ad valorem tax rate of \$0.41 as set forth in Section 1 herein is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected on one hundred percent (100%) of each One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars worth of property located within the boundaries of Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 on January 1, 2017, as valued by the Harris County Central Appraisal District and made taxable by law.

Section 3: The Tax Assessor-Collector is hereby directed to assess, extend and enter upon the tax rolls of the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 for the current year the amounts and rates herein levied and to keep a current account of same. All collection of such taxes, as well as collection of taxes owed for prior years, to include penalty and interest thereof, shall be deposited in the official depository of the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1. \$0.311 of the ad valorem tax shall be distributed to the Debt Service Fund and \$0.099 of the ad valorem tax shall be distributed to the Maintenance and Operation Tax Fund.

An individual who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older shall be entitled to an exemption of \$50,000.00 of the appraised value of the residential homestead as provided in Section 11.13 of the Texas Tax Code.

An individual who is disabled shall be entitled to an exemption of \$50,000.00 of Section 5: the appraised value of the residential homestead as provided in Section 11.13 of the Texas Tax Code.

A disabled veteran is entitled to an exemption from taxation of a portion of the assessed value of a property he owns and designates as provided in Section 11.22 of the Texas Tax Code.

This Ordinance constitutes an official action by the Board of Directors of the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 concerning the foregoing matters and shall take effect in full force and effect upon and after its passage.
