ORDER AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL 20% PENALTY ON DELINQUENT TAX ACCOUNTS

THE STATE OF TEXAS

HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1	

Section 1: Pursuant to Texas Tax Code, Section 33.11, as amended, sixty (60) days after the date the personal property taxes become delinquent, all personal property tax accounts which are delinquent for the tax year 2022 will incur additional penalties in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the sum of the tax, penalty and interest then due, and to be due, in order to help defray the cost of collection of the same. The Tax Collector shall deliver a notice of delinquency and of this additional penalty to the owner of each personal property tax account, at least thirty (30) and not more than sixty (60) days before the date the additional twenty percent (20%) penalties are incurred.

Section 2: Pursuant to Texas Tax Code, Section 33.01, as amended, on July 1, 2023 all real property tax accounts which are delinquent for the tax year 2022 will incur additional penalties in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the sum of the tax, penalty and interest then due, and to be due, in order to help defray the cost of collection of the same. The Tax Collector shall deliver a notice of delinquency and of this additional penalty to the owner of each real property tax account, at least thirty (30) and not more than sixty (60) days before July 1, 2023.

Section 3: The Board of Directors (the "Board") has retained and contracted with Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP, to collect delinquent taxes pursuant to Section 6.30(c) of the Property Tax Code, and that it is the intention of this Board to comply in all respects with Sections 33.07 and 33.08 of such Tax Code.
