ORDER DETERMINING AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR 2023 TAX YEAR

THE STATE OF TEXAS

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 (the "District"), is required to levy and cause to be assessed and collected ad valorem taxes upon all property (real, personal or mixed) subject to taxation within the boundaries of the District;

WHEREAS, the Board is required to adopt an order determining ad valorem tax exemptions for the upcoming tax year prior to May 1 of each year.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 THAT:

I.

The Board hereby grants the following exemption(s) from ad valorem taxation for the 2023 tax year:

Residential homestead exemption to any individual who is disabled or is 65 years of age or older in the amount of \$50,000 as provided in §11.13(d), Texas Tax Code; and

A disabled veteran is entitled to an exemption from taxation of a portion of the assessed value of a property he owns and designates as provided in Section 11.22 of the Texas Tax Code

II.

The Board hereby authorizes the Tax Assessor/Collector for the District to grant the exemption stated above to taxpayers meeting the qualifications therefor and who have filed application for same, all in accordance with Chapter 11 of the Tax Code.

III.

No other tax exemptions shall be granted by the District.
